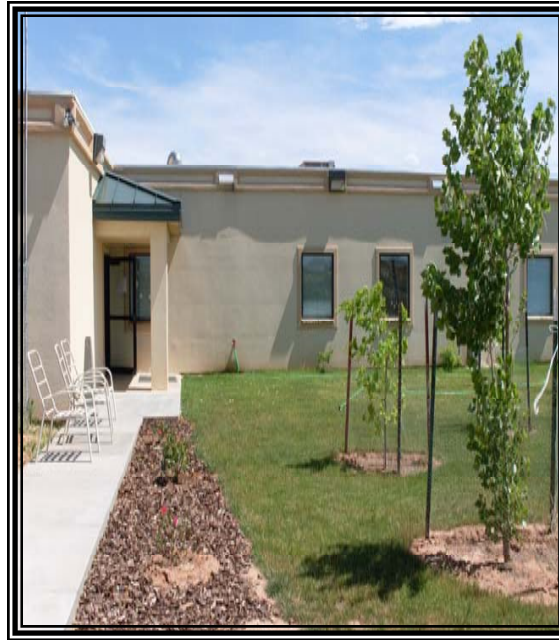

The mission of the Ute Indian Tribe Red Pine Residential Treatment Center is to promote wellness and healing from the use of alcohol and drugs by providing individualized, comprehensive and culturally-based treatment and recovery services to all the Ute Tribal members of the Uintah and Ouray Reservation, as well as others who may be in need of these services.

The following services are provided:

(once admitted)

- Alcohol & drug/Evaluation
- Individual, Group & Traditional Therapy, using multiple approaches
- Male & Female Sweats & Coed Sweats
- 12 Step & 12 Traditions
- Medicine Wheel Concepts , & Red Road approach
- Holistic Healing-Integration of Spiritual, Emotional, Mental & Physical healing.
- Physical Wellness,
- Family Involvement
- Dual Diagnoses
- MRT – Moral Recognition Therapy

Enrollment Process

1. Call or visit Red Pine RTC. Ask for the Intake Coordinator. Request an Intake Packet or Intake packet can also be accessed at utetribe.com.
 2. Complete INTAKE PACKET & submit to: Intake Coordinator.
 3. Submit the following documents:
 - Certificate of Indian Blood
 - Clear T.B. Results
 - Complete Physical/medication list
 - Court Referral (if court ordered) DCFS / Probation
 - Criminal Background sent in by client
 - Alcohol and Drug Assessment
 - Photo ID
 4. Once everything is turned in to the Intake Coordinator, it will be reviewed by the clinical team and you will be notified by mail or called by phone of your acceptance.
- FEE
- There is no fee for individuals who show proof of enrollment with the Ute Indian Tribe. For Non-Tribal Members fee is \$100.00 per day for 65 day sessions, The Ute Tribe graciously offers 4 scholarships to any individual who desires treatment. A priority will be given to Native Americans, and then offered on a first come, first serve basis with completed packets.
- Covers the following:
Room & Board, all Clinical Services, Case Management, Transportation, Basic Toiletries, Arts & Crafts, & Educational Supplies.



Red Pine is a 20 bed, Co-Ed, Substance Abuse Residential Treatment Center for clients from all backgrounds, 18 years & older. Ute Tribal members first preference.
