

Ute Indian Tribe Garbage Collection

Every year the Ute Indian Tribe manages approximately 1000 tons of garbage. Here is some helpful information and some suggestions concerning the trash collection services.

- Please face trash can towards the road. (Face arrow towards street)
- All garbage needs to be INSIDE the trash can.
- DO NOT overload the trash cans.
- DO NOT use for hot ashes, solvents, paints, or any other flammable liquids..
- DO NOT leave your trash cans out overnight. (this risks them being knocked over and not being picked up)
- DO NOT use for hazardous materials. (No tanks of any kind)
- DO NOT dispose of Metals, Construction debris, Tires, and drugs of any kind. (Any illegal drugs found will be documented and reported to the BIA Ft. Duchesne Police Department.

Monday - Coonsville to Bacon Park Route.

Tuesday - FtDuchesne, HWY40, Hilltop, Gusher, and Lapoint areas

Wednesday - Pelican, Ouray, Randlett, Arcadia, and Myton areas

Thursday - Neola and surrounding areas
